Subject: Employee Survey Results

The All Employee Survey Results have been received for the Office of Fire & Aviation. This includes employees at the Fire Center (FC-200) and the National Office (FA-100). Though this is a continuous effort, and we still have lots of work to do, I am extremely encouraged by the results and all of your accomplishments that are reflected in these ratings.

Attached is a chart that shows the overall ratings for the Office of Fire & Aviation as well as the ratings Bureau-wide. It also shows the results from the previous survey in 1998 and how far we have come. One item that I am particularly proud of is that we have had significantly improved ratings in all of the topic areas. For examples Computer Systems/Support, Regulatory Process Management, and Leadership each increased 14 percentage points or more. This represents a total increase of 102 percentage points over all nine areas. Bureau-wide the ratings have gone up 29 percentage points.

I would like to thank everyone for all of your hard work to improve the work environment, the way we do business, the Office of Fire & Aviation, and the BLM.

A complete survey results package has been sent to the Management Team for routing. In addition, a copy of the entire survey, for all offices, will be posted to the Bureau intranet site. When that happens, you will be notified immediately.
