Subject: Crew Resource Management/ Aerial Supervision Module Training

Training for BLM Aerial Supervision Modules (ASM) will be conducted April 17 - 22, 2000 at the National Interagency Fire Center (NFC) in Boise, Idaho. Training will include two days of Crew Resource Management (CRM), and three days of simulation exercises. This training is mandatory for Bureau ASM 1 and 2 and Air Tactical Pilot trainees as defined in IB No. OF&A 2000-017. It is anticipated that USFS and Alaska Division of Forestry personnel will also be included in the training.

Although limited, space in the Crew Resource Management Training for fully qualified BLM Air Tactical Group Supervisors is available.

A block of 20 rooms has been reserved at the Best Western Vista Inn at 208-336-8100 listed under BLM CRM/ASM training. The rooms are \$60.99 per night and reservations must be made prior to April 3, 2000.

The training begins at 0800 hours on April 17, in the Multi-Purpose Room at NIFC. CRM training will occur on April 17 and 18.
