Subject: Fire Conference 2000

The purpose of this IB is to alert you to Fire Conference 2000 and urge you to submit papers and/or posters for the session.

The conference is scheduled for the Town and Country Hotel and Convention Center in San Diego, CA during November 27 - December 1, 2000. The conference will include sessions on the social and economic aspects of fire, fire prevention and education, wildland fire use, air quality and smoke management, fire history, invasive species and fire, the application of fire in ecosystem and habitat restoration, wildlife-fire interactions, fire and watersheds, fire meteorology and climatology, and fire and insect/pathogen interactions. The conference is currently cosponsored by the California Association of Fire Ecology (CAFÉ), Tall Timbers Research Station, the Joint Fire Science Program, and the International Association of Wildland Fire. Additional sponsors are being sought.
