Subject: Reemployed Annuitants and 1039 Hours Waivers

The Office of Personnel Management granted waivers which allowed the hiring of annuitants without the dual-payment penalty and the extension of the 1039 hour appointments, to deal with this extremely heavy fire year.

This includes assigning such employees to emergency fire rehabilitation work to support incidents which occurred during the 2000 fire season.

Also, the Department has stated that there is no provision to reduce the 1039 hours a temporary seasonal firefighter may work in future fire seasons because of the waivers granted this year.

These waivers expire on December 31, 2000.
