Subject: Construction Funding

Based upon your responses to Information Bulletin, OF&A 2001-014, Fire Construction Contingency Funding, and the recommendations of a committee consisting of representatives of the State Fire Management Officers and Office of Fire and Aviation, the following projects are approved. For your information, requests exceeded available resources by \$3.4 million for contingency funding and \$1.56 million for A&E funding. These requests will be revisited at midyear.

All 2810 approvals should be charged to the appropriate construction project code. All 2852 approvals should use project code 8053.

Arizona: \$150,000 for the Kingman seat base (2810).

California: \$74,800 for the Salt Wells fire station (2810).

Colorado: \$50,000 for the Grand Junction air center (2852).

Eastern States: \$150,000 for the training center (2810).

Idaho: \$65,000 for the Hailey fire station (2852).  
\$10,000 for the Burley fire office (2852).  
\$45,000 for the Soda Springs fire station (2852).  
\$70,000 for the Soda Springs fire station (2810).

Montana: \$140,000 for the Miles City fire station (2810).

NTSC: \$240,000 for hiring engineers (2810).  
\$100,000 for project support (2852).

Nevada: \$50,000 for Elko office (2810).

Oregon: \$ 50,000 for the Vale Dispatch Center (2852).  
\$200,000 for the Vale Dispatch Center (2810).

Utah: \$200,000 for the Cedar City air tanker base (2810).  
\$100,000 for the Vernal fire station (2810).
