Subject: Wildland Fire Situation Analysis (WFSA) Web Based Training

Through interagency coordination, a web site has been developed to familiarize personnel with the WFSA process. The intended audience is anyone who would be involved with the WFSA process, specifically line officers, fire staff, and resource specialists. The web address is

To gain access as a new user, click on the New User sign-in and complete the data fields. The site provides step by step instructions on the WFSA with a practice scenario at the end. The user is able to complete the instruction at their own pace and can return at any time with their own log-in ID and password. A conservative estimate of eight hours is needed to complete the course for a person unfamiliar with the process. If someone is familiar with the process and works quickly, the course can be done in three hours, introduction through the practice scenario.

The WFSA web based training provides the opportunity for individual offices to track personnel who have completed the course.
