Subject: Prescribed Fire and Fuels Management Accomplishments DD: 11/01/00

Program Area: Prescribed fire and fuels management.

Purpose: This is an attempt to capture the actual work accomplishments within the fuels management program. The current reporting system does not provide an overview of the total program workload as it relates to planning, inventory, coordination and other related work within the prescribed fire and fuels management program. Each state should provide a brief summary of their prescribed fire and fuels management program accomplishments for FY2000 using the attached format. The actual reportable accomplishments (number of projects and the number of acres completed) do not need to be reiterated as they will be taken directly from the fire reporting system.

Timeframe: Responses are due to the Office of Fire and Aviation by 11/01/00.

Budget Impact: None.

Background: Most State Office fire management staffs have stated that the current prescribed fire and fuels management reporting system is strictly focused on current accomplishments and does not reflect the total workload needed to achieve the acres treated. Furthermore, the system does not reflect work accomplished in one FY toward out year projects.

Coordination: Several State Offices have commented on the existing reporting system and requested an opportunity to identify additional accomplishments within the program.

## **Fuels Program Accomplishment Summary**
